OUR EAGLE BOY was never far back, raced far wide through the second turn, responded to steady urging and was up in the final yards. CHU AND I chased the leaders from the outside, also responded when set down for the drive and gave way grudgingly to the winner late. HE'S ALL HEART was away alertly then appeared hard to rate, stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge nearing the three-sixteenths pole and yielded late. HARBOR WIND sprinted clear soon after the start, responded when challenged nearing the half and gave way through the final furlong. SWISS LIGHTNING was void of early speed, raced far wide through the second turn, angled out approaching the stretch and failed to menace. TIMELY NOTE raced off the pacesetters from the inside and lacked the needed rally. RORKES DRIFT showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention.
