### Footnotes

SCAT DADDYBABY sprinted clear soon after the start, saved ground while setting the pace, was well rated into the lane, turned back the bid of MEMPHIS BEACH in mid-stretch and drew clear of that rival through the closing yards. MEMPHIS BEACH broke sharply to stalk the pace of the winner from the outside, moved up to engage that foe with a furlong to run but could not match strides late. JOHNSKI raced unhurried early, angled out in mid-stretch, reached a striking position but failed to gain in the drive. KOOKY SALUKI was allowed to settle early, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. UGOTTABCATTY chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after going a half.
