DIGLETT unhurried early, moved up strongly along the inside on the backstretch, angled out on the turn, took the lead leaving the quarter pole and quickly drew clear. POKER BRAD dropped back early, came four-wide into the stretch, angled further out during the drive and finished well to be along for the place. JUMRON WON allowed to settle in stride while racing four-wide, continued wide into the stretch, offered a mild bid nearing the eighth pole, but was unable to sustain his rally. JADE GREEN was two-wide while racing between horses, but lacked a rally. ALFURUNE came three-wide into the stretch and was unable to seriously threaten. GAME TICKET was outrun. SABERTOOTH saved ground setting the pressured pace for six and one-half furlongs and gave way readily when headed. HANDSOME WILL DO forced the pace from along the outside for five furlongs and stopped.
