**Footnotes**

PERFECT PIE broke sharply to stalk the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the quarter, moved up to take command with a furlong to run and held sway to the wire. INCLUDE THE BABY was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, moved up to take a brief lead nearing the quarter, could not match strides with the winner in the drive but finished well to be clearly second best. ROSSI RESERVE was taken back early, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. C. R. YOUTICKLEME lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and failed to menace. LA PEPPER set a pressured pace from the outside and weakened after going a half.
