CLASS INCLUDED raced off the dueling leaders early, moved up from the outside to take command nearing the quarter, opened a clear margin and was fully extended to hold off the closing PLAYFUL ARGUMENT through the final yards. PLAYFUL ARGUMENT lacked early speed, raced far wide through the second turn, responded to steady encouragement and was gaining on the winner late. SOUL IN ONE showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn, angled out further in mid-stretch and finished with good energy. THE GANG AND I was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out nearing the eighth pole and finished evenly in the drive. JUDGING MIMI lacked early speed, saved ground into the lane and did not reach contention. ELUSIVE NOISE broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside and weakened through the final furlong. CARRABELLE HARBOR was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and weakened after going three-quarters.
