MIDNIGHT MOTION was allowed to settle into stride, responded when roused nearing the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide to make her bid, forged command inside the furlong marker, and held sway under stern urging. WILD BUT FREE was unhurried early, made a steady advance circling five wide, and was along in time to earn the place. DYSFUNCTIONAL LADY set the pressured pace racing along the inside, weakened during the drive, but had enough left to hold the show. WILMAGLEN pressed the pace racing between horses for a half and tired. COUNTRY PARADISE chased the pace racing three wide, angled in leaving the turn, but faltered entering the stretch and retreated. SISTER ISABEL stalked the pace racing along the inside, but came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out.
