Footnotes

OLYMPIC LIGHTS raced off the pacesetters early, angled out nearing the quarter, reached NEWFOUND GOLD inside the furlong marker and drew clear through the final yards. NEWFOUND GOLD sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, turned back the bid of CAT ON BASE nearing the quarter, re-cleared but could not resist the winner late. CAT ON BASE broke sharply to chase the pace of NEWFOUND GOLD from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the quarter and gave way in the drive. NOBLE JUAN lacked early speed, angled out nearing the quarter, altered course soon after and finished with some late run when straightened away. DEMOSTHENES chased the leaders from the outside, steadied nearing the three-sixteenths pole and gave way thereafter. SEND SILVER chased the leaders from the inside for three furlongs and gave way. The stewards conducted an inquiry concerning the steadying of DEMOSTHENES at the quarter pole and after reviewing the films concluded OLYMPIC LIGHTS had caused the infraction while angling outside at the quarter marker and was disqualified from first and placed fifth.
