Footnotes

HE'S A BARN RAT raced off the leaders early, angled outside into the lane, responded to steady urging, brushed with KICKAPOLE in the final yards and proved best. OLLY BLAST broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside with BARTUS CHRISTAIN, opened a clear lead nearing the nine-sixteenths pole, increased that advantage into the stretch but could not hold the winner safe late. KICKAPOLE was away alertly then raced just off the leaders from the outside, was brushed by the winner late and finished with good energy. CLURMOR lacked early speed, saved ground into the stretch and found his best stride late. LOVE OUR KINZIE raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and failed to rally. WALLY BALLOU lagged, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention. BARTUS CHRISTIAN dueled for early advantage from the outside and gradually weakened after going six furlongs.
