Footnotes

CAMP PENDLETON stalked the pace of NICK'S GOLD from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the five-sixteenths pole, opened a clear margin into the lane and held IT'S OUT PLEASURE safe in the drive. IT'S OUR PLEASURE raced off the pacesetters from the inside, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths marker and was gaining on the winner late. ADAM N RYAN showed no early speed, raced far wide through the second turn, reached a contending position into the stretch but failed to gain on the top pair in the drive. SEND SILVER was never far back, raced wide through the second turn and lacked the needed late response. LA CAPITANA chased the leaders from the outside, steadied nearing the three-eighths pole and finished evenly thereafter. WOLFGANG (IRE) was off a step slow, raced off the pacesetters from the inside and failed to rally. NICK'S GOLD broke sharply to open a clear lead before going a quarter, raced off the rail while setting the pace and weakened after going three-quarters. DIAMOND TOUCH was void of early foot, raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor. The rider of LA CAPITANA lodged an objection against CAMP PENDLETON concerning the steadying of her mount at the three-eighths pole and after reviewing the films the stewards made no change.
