Footnotes

WASSERMAN lacked early speed, began to work his way forward from the outside approaching the stretch, responded to steady urging and caught TRUE METROPOLITAN in the final strides. TRUE METROPOLITAN was bumped at the start then allowed to settle in stride, moved up from the outside into the lane, caught TROPIC STORM in the final yards but could not hold the winner off late. TROPIC STORM was away alertly to stalk the early pace of FLAMETHROWINTEXAN from the outside, moved up to take command with a quarter to run, opened a clear lead but could not resist the closers in the final yards. ASSESSMENT was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground into the stretch, steadied nearing the eighth pole, angled outside and finished with some late run. SCHOOLIN YOU showed no early speed, saved ground into the stretch, veered in and out while rallying and improved his position in the drive. CALL ON CARSON chased the leaders from the outside and gave way gradually after going three-quarters. FLAMETHROWINTEXAN went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, raced off the rail into the stretch and after six furlongs. HONOUR THE WEST was never far back, raced off the rail into the lane and weakened. NATIONHOOD raced off the pacesetters from between foes and failed to rally. LUHUK'S DANCER raced just off the leaders from the inside and weakened after a half. SOUTHERN AFRICA raced off the leaders from the outside,

moved further out into the stretch and weakened. DILIGENT PROSPECT raced wide through the second turn and weakened.
