Footnotes

MASTER'S BLUFF was never far back, raced far wide through the turn, reached ADVANCEMENT with a furlong to run, vied with that rival through a stiff drive and proved best. ADVANCEMENT broke sharply to duel for the early advantage, responded when challenged by the winner in mid-stretch, vied into late lane and just missed. SHARP FOCUS raced off the leaders from between foes, moved outside through the turn, reached a striking position with a furlong to run but failed to gain on the top pair in the drive. DOCTOR BRUCE S. was off a step slow, raced off the pacesetters from the inside and finished evenly in the drive. ORCAS GOLD showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to threaten. TWO O'CLOCK DRAW bobbled at the break, pressed the pace from the outside and gave way after going a half. JUST GONNA BE broke inward, dueled for the lead from the inside and weakened after a half.
