ROYAL SHRINE raced off the pacesetters early, moved far wide through the turn, drifted in while taking command nearing the sixteenth pole, was checked, straightened away and continued on to prove best in the final yards. KOOL COMIC duelled for the lead from the inside with ONE LUCKY HOSS, disposed of that rival into the lane but could not resist the winner late. PASSION LIVES HERE was taken back at the start, raced wide through the turn, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths pole and finished with good energy. ONE LUCKY HOSS broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way to KOOL COMIC after going a half. NEWAUKUM CREEK raced off the pacesetters throughout and finished evenly in the drive. EZINMOTION showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not reach contention. BE THERE JOE was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half.
