Footnotes

THE GREAT FACE broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside, responded when set down for the drive, drifted out slightly through the final furlong and held off RAISE THE BLUFF to prevail. RAISE THE BLUFF raced off the leaders from between rivals, angled out nearing the five-sixteenths marker, split foes into the lane, moved up to reach the winner inside the furlong marker but could not get by that rival in the drive. WASSERMAN showed no early speed, raced far wide into the lane and finished with good energy. SCHOOLIN YOU raced just off the leaders from the inside throughout and finished with late interest. GOTAGHOSTOFACHANCE chased the leaders from the inside and lacked the needed closing response. TRICKEY TREVOR was off a step slow, raced wide through both turns, moved up to a striking position nearing the quarter and finished evenly in the drive. NORM'S NEPHEW chased the leaders from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. SINISTER MINISTER lacked early speed while racing from between rivals, moved outside through the second turn and failed to menace. DILIGENT PROSPECT pressed the pace from the outside for three-quarters and weakened.

DON'TWRITEMEOFF was away alertly then allowed to settle off the leaders, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. WANNA RUNNER was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not offer a bid. COURTING SEATTLE was never far back while racing from between foes and gradually weakened. The rider of RAISE THE BLUFF lodged an objection against THE GREAT FACE concerning the drifting out of the winner through the final furlong and after reviewing the films the Stewards made no change.
