Footnotes

CHRIS GO broke sharply to stalk the leaders from the outside, moved up to gain command with three-sixteenths to run and drew off through the lane with little need of urging. RINGO'S GOLD lacked early speed, saved ground into the stretch and finished with good energy. FRESH MANGOLD was bumped at the start, lacked early foot, raced far wide through the turn and finished with a steady bid. STORMIN' PETER was never far back while racing along the inside, moved up for a striking position into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. DOR L'DOR went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter and gave way after going a half. BEAU CZAR raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and finished evenly in the drive. ELVIE'S BOY was void of early speed, raced between foes into the lane and failed to menace. BUTTERONMYBISCUIT was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from between rivals into the lane and did not reach contention. FOREVERYOUANDI was bumped at the start, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor. HAZARD CREEK was off slow and lagged throughout.
