Footnotes

FASTER THAN DUKE lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out further into the lane, gained a slight edge inside the furlong marker and held LEADERSHIP off to gamely prevail. LEADERSHIP was away alertly to stalk the pace of BRUDDA CLYDE from the outside, moved up to engage that rival approaching the stretch, vied through a prolonged drive and gave way grudgingly to the winner. FOLLOW THROUGH was never far back while racing along the inside, moved up for a contending position in mid-stretch and finished willingly in the drive. FIRST LAST CHANCE hesitated at the start, raced far wide through the turn and finished full of run. BRUDDA CLYDE set a pressured pace from off the rail and gave way through the final furlong. ROYAL EAGLE showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and failed to menace. TY GOES GOLD hopped at the start, then hustled along to press the pace from the inside and weakened after going a half. DELINQUENCY raced off the leaders from the outside and gradually weakened.
