Footnotes

COULDABENTHEWHISKY was never far back, raced far wide through the turn, responded to aggressive handling and was up with a rush to prevail in the final yards. ROCKY'S QUEST was away alertly to stalk the leaders from the outside, also responded when set down for the drive and just missed. HOLLYWOOD HARBOR broke sharply to duel with POLISH DOLLAR from the outside, disposed of that rival after going five furlongs, opened a clear margin and just failed to last. POLISH DOLLAR dueled for the lead from the inside and gave way through the final furlong. SLIM PICKINS lagged early, raced off the rail throughout and found his best stride late. POSSE POWER broke awkwardly, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. SARATOGA BOOT lacked early foot, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor.
