### Footnotes

KOOKY SALUKI was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders, moved up to take a slight edge inside the quarter and drew clear through the lane. NEWFOUND GOLD sprinted clear at once, turned back the bid of OUR EAGLE BOY nearing the half mile marker, could not match strides with the winner in the drive but held on determinedly to hold the place. OUR EAGLE BOY was bumped at the start, stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up offer a bid nearing the half but failed to sustain his bid in the drive. COME AWAY HOME showed no early speed, reached a contending position from the inside nearing the quarter but lacked the needed closing response. SHARP FOCUS was off slow and checked, raced off the pacesetters from the outside and failed to rally.
