BLOW IT UP was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, moved up to gain command nearing the five-sixteenths pole, opened a clear lead and held off LA PATRIOTTE in the final yards to prevail. LA PATRIOTTE raced off the leader early, moved outside through the turn, offered a bid late but could not get by the winner. PROFITBOX showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with good energy. BUTTON EM UP broke sharply to set a pressured pace and gave way after going five furlongs. BABY SNOOKS pressed the pace from between foes and weakened after a half. GUESSAWAY was void of early speed, saved ground throughout and did not menace. JUST CHUB raced off the leaders from between foes and failed to threaten. CORAL CREEK pressed the pace from the inside and weakened after the opening quarter.
