BIANCONI BABY went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace, began to drift out into the lane and held sway to the wire. KARIS MAKAW bobbled at the break, raced just off the leaders, moved outside into the stretch, could not gain on the winner late but finished with good courage. SARIANO lacked early foot, raced wide into the lane and showed some late run. SUMMER SYMPHONY raced off the rail throughout and finished evenly. UNINHIBITED SONG chased the leaders from off the rail throughout and gave way in the drive. ARCO IRIS was off a step slow, raced in contention for six furlongs and gave way. ONEOFACAT raced wide through both turns and failed to menace. SHE'S A BOMBSHELL was off slow, saved ground throughout and did not threaten. SWINGN' NOTES showed brief speed from the inside and weakened after a half.
