Footnotes

NO GIVEAWAY was allowed to settle early while racing along the inside, began to advance with three furlongs to run, moved between foes in mid-stretch and caught QUIET CASH in the final yards. QUIET CASH stalked the leaders from the inside, moved up to engage with a quarter to run, opened a clear lead with a furlong to run but could not resist the winner late. DESERT BOOM was never far back while racing from off the rail, angled outside with three-sixteenths to run and finished willingly. HARVARD AVENUE showed no early speed, moved far outside into the stretch and finished with some late run. ADREAMISBORN was void of early speed, raced wide into the lane and finished with good energy. FLAMETHROWINTEXAN broke sharply to duel for the early advantage with SABERTOOTH, gave that rival a clear lead after going a half, responded into the stretch and gradually gave way. MR. MAKAH lacked early speed, moved outside into the lane and failed to menace. R. ASSOCIATE raced off the rail throughout and did not threaten. TURBAN was hard to rate early, moved up to a contending position before going a half and weakened in the drive. SABERTOOTH dueled for the lead from the inside, opened a clear lead nearing the five-eighths pole and weakened into the lane. SNORTER raced off the rail throughout and was not a factor.
