SHOWME YOURFRIENDS was bumped at the start, stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command with a furlong to run and proved best. AVALON BEACH was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way grudgingly to the winner in the drive. MARVIN'S MAGIC was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge nearing the quarter and gave way through the final furlong. EL GRAN BEBE lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and found his best stride late. VEGAS FLYER chased the leaders from the inside into the lane and weakened. OLD WEST raced off the pacesetters from between rivals, moved far outside through the turn and gave way in the drive. GDANZ XPRESS was off slow and failed to reach contention.
