Footnotes

BUDROYALE stalked the issue racing in hand, angled out entering the second turn and swiftly reeled in KID KATABATIC, gained command at the head of the lane and held sway under a strong hand ride. MIKE K settled saving ground through the opening half mile, angled out nearing the three-eighths pole and ranged into striking distance a quarter to home, loomed the danger while four wide but was held at bay. KID KATABATIC set the pressured pace to the quarter pole, battled gamely but was unable to match strides through the lane. THETRUTHISOUTTHERE was bumped early and dropped back, made a late rally splitting horses in the upper stretch and posted a mild bid. WEST COAST WARRIOR pressed KID KATABATIC throughout, was hard used and weakened entering the stretch dropping out. WORLDLY WAYS (GB) was jostled early and fell back, made a middle move to close the gap entering the second turn but flattened out in the lane. DASH EIGHT steadily retreated, and was no factor. CLASSIC CAT gave a dull effort and dropped out to trail.
