Footnotes

ADREAMISBORN was off a step slow then allowed to settle well off the leaders, began to advance nearing the three-eighths pole, drifted in while rallying into the lane, opened a clear lead in mid-stretch and held DEMON WARLOCK at bay to the wire. DEMON WARLOCK raced just off the leaders from the inside, responded when set down for the drive, moved to within striking distance of the winner in deep stretch but could not reach that rival late. MR. MAKAH was void of early speed, moved far outside approaching the stretch and finished with good energy. AMERICAN FURY lacked early foot, moved into contention into the lane from between rivals, was bumped and lost an iron with three-sixteenths to run and stayed on to improve his position late. METATRON went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way in the drive. ROYAL PLACE raced wide into both turns, was bumped nearing the sixteenth pole and finished willingly. VERKADE chased the leaders from the outside early, offered a bid nearing the quarter and failed to sustain his rally. POKER BRAD showed no early speed, raced wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. GRATITUDE ATTACK saved ground throughout to no avail. BEST ON TAP broke sharply to show brief speed and weakened. DEPUTY COUNTRY chased the leaders from the outside for three-quarters and weakened. SALT GRINDER chased the leaders from the outside, drifted out to bump rival while tiring

into the lane and gave way. The rider of AMERICAN FURY called an objection against the winner concerning the bumping incident nearing the three-sixteenths pole and after reviewing the films the Stewards concluded that SALT GRINDER had drifted out and bumped AMERICAN FURY and therefore held ADREAMISBORN blameless in the incident.
