SO WHATABOUT broke sharply to stalk the leaders from the outside, moved up to gain command with a furlong to run and drew clear through the final yards. A BLACK THORN was bumped at the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and yielded to the winner in the drive. WEST SEATTLE BOY lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished with good energy. AFLEET PETE raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. MILITARY DEPUTY was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground into the lane and also finished evenly. HUZYURHUCKLEBERRY chased the leaders from the inside and gave way through the final furlong. YASOU was bumped at the start and lagged throughout.
