TAIF was never far back while racing along the inside, angled outside of BOGACHIEL in mid-stretch and wore down that rival in the closing yards to prevail. BOGACHIEL broke in stride to take command at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and yielded to the winner late. MARGO'S GIFT lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the stretch, angled out nearing the eighth pole and finished with good energy. SEMINOLE BRAVE hopped at the start, raced just off the leaders from the outside and lacked the needed closing response. OLYMPIC LIGHTS was bumped at the start, raced from between rivals through the back-stretch and gradually gave way. EMANCIPATED broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and gave way after going a half. DIXIE MEISTER was off slow and bumped and lagged throughout.
