Footnotes

QUEEN SARABI broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside, relinquished his command to TASHA'S FLIRT nearing the half, angled outside approaching the stretch, regained the lead and held off KITTY'S HONEY to prevail. KITTY'S HONEY was never far back while racing along the inside, moved out into the stretch and was gaining on the winner late. FOXWOOD BELLE raced off the leaders from the inside, moved between rivals in the final furlong and finished with good courage. TASHA'S FLIRT was away alertly to duel for the early advantage with QUEEN SARABI, opened a clear lead nearing the five-sixteenths marker and gave way through the final eighth. RAGING LADY was void of early speed, raced wide into the lane and did not threaten. NINA WIN showed no early speed, raced far wide into the lane and was not a factor. LADY ELIZA hopped at the start, raced just of the leaders from the outside and weakened.
