**Footnotes**

DO YOU THINK broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside, opened a clear lead with a furlong to run and drew off as a handy winner. HAPPY HOLLY was bumped at the start, duelled for the lead from the outside with the winner, was no match for that rival in the drive but finished well to be clearly second best. CASCADE PARK was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside and finished willingly. PRAIRIE GROVE lacked early speed, saved ground into the lane, came out to avoid the drifting PEARL BLACK nearing the sixteenth pole and lost her best chance of a better placing. VELOCITY CAT was void of early foot, angled outside nearing the five-sixteenths marker and found her best stride late. DIAMOND BRITE was off slow, raced wide through the turn, was bumped nearing the sixteenth pole and lost her best chance for a better placing. SKIES THE PLAN lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the lane, was bumped hard nearing the sixteenth pole and also lost a chance for a better placing. PEARL BLACK was never far back while racing from the inside, drifted out while tiring nearing the sixteenth marker and continued to give way. BOY THATS THE KEY was bumped at the start, raced off the rail throughout and did not threaten. JUST RITA showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. CASSIE SLEW raced off the pacesetters from the outside and failed to menace. ROB 'N POPPINS was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half. The rider of SKIES THE PLAN lodged an objection against PRAIRIE GROVE concerning the bumping incident at the sixteenth pole and after reviewing the films the Stewards concluded PEARL BLACK had caused the infraction and since she had placed behind all participants, no change was made.
