Footnotes

PORT WAKEFIELD stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage DUCOTI nearing the three-sixteenths marker, vied through a vigorous drive and proved best. DUCOTI sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, responded when challenged by the winner nearing into the stretch, vied and grudgingly gave way to that rival in the closing yards. LADY ROCHELLE was never far back, raced wide through the turn, could not reach the top pair in the drive but finished with good energy. BARTAB raced off the pacesetters from the inside and finished evenly late. WAY TO GO LO was off slow then allowed to settle, raced wide through the turn and failed to rally. SEATTLE GAME threw her head at the break, moved up quickly to chase the leaders from the inside, steadied nearing the five-eighths marker and did not threaten thereafter. PRETTY DARN GOOD raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the turn and weakened.
