MAKORS MARK allowed to settle in stride while racing four-wide throughout, gained a slight lead nearing the eighth pole and gradually drew clear. ONLY POE KNOWS vied for the lead while and finished well to edge APRIL SURPRISE for the place. APRIL SURPRISE dueled for the lead while racing two-wide and held on gamely during the drive. EDNEATOR never far back, came three-wide into the stretch, angled further out during the drive and went evenly late. SULLIVANITIS bobbled at the start to get away behind his field, came five-wide into the stretch and failed to menace. HANDSOME WILL DO dueled for the lead from along the inside and tired. BE THE BUNNY saved ground to the stretch, swung out for the drive and was not a factor.
