WHAT'S THE PLAN was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the outside with LOOKS LIKE SNOW, disposed of that rival after going three furlongs, opened a clear lead, drifted out through the lane and held sway to the wire. STORMIN' BUBSY stumbled at the break, recovered quickly to race off the leaders from the outside, angled inside nearing the three-sixteenths marker, could not reach the winner in the drive but held on well to save the place. SPENDING showed no early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths pole and finished with good late speed. LOOKS LIKE SNOW was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the inside for three furlongs and gave way. THOUGHTFUL GUY lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention. KASPARONE was never far back, saved ground throughout and gradually weakened.
