CARIBOO ROAD dueled for the lead from the outside, opened a clear margin into the lane and quickly drew off. MASTER'S BLUFF raced off the leaders from the inside, angled out approaching the stretch, could not gain on the winner in the drive but finished well to be clearly second best. PRIVATE PASSWORD was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside and gave way to the winner after going a half. KISSING RUBY raced off the pacesetters throughout and finished evenly. WHITE RIVER PIRATE showed no early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention. GALWAY GUINNESS chased the leaders from the outside for three furlongs and weakened. LUNA TICK lacked early foot, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten. DIAMOND PEAK was void of early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not offer a bid.
