GLO BOU LIZA broke sharply, set the pace along the rail, turned back a bid by PERHAPS PERHAPS at the quarter, responded to steady urging and drew clear late. PERHAPS PERHAPS was away alertly, pressed the pace from between foes, moved up at the quarter pole to challenge the winner, could not match strides with that rival in the late going but was clearly second best. SICILY GRACE was never far back and racing in good position, moved out four wide on the turn and lacked the necessary closing response when called upon. PRETTY CAPABLE trailed off the rail early, raced four wide on the turn then five wide into the lane and improved her position. ATTA LORA was void of early speed and failed to threaten. T J TIMBER was unhurried early along the rail and never a factor. BUTTON EM UP stalked the pace, raced four wide on the turn and was through after a half.
