BRAND KNEW was away alertly to duel for the early advantage from the outside, opened a clear lead with a furlong to run and held sway to the wire. RINGO'S GOLD lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with good energy. RICKERSGETTINANGRY chased the leaders from the outside and gave way in the drive. BRACE FOR IMPACT raced off the leaders from between foes and lacked the needed closing response. SEVENTEENMILEDRIVE showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out further in mid-stretch and found his best stride late. LAUDRI raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and failed to rally. WINORBEGONE was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside and weakened through the final furlong. COUGAR BOB lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor.
