LADY VIVIEN was bumped at the start, lagged early, angled far outside approaching the stretch, responded to steady handling and was up through the final yards. TALK TO MY LAWYER stumbled at the start and was bumped, raced off the pacesetters from the inside early, steadied nearing the quarter, moved between foes with a furlong to run but could not match strides with the winner late. LADY HOKULEA set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way through the final sixteenth. SHE'S A TIME BOMB chased the leaders from the outside, gave way into the lane and came back to finished with some late interest. LADY DAKOTA was hustled along to press the pace from the outside and weakened after going a half. JEWEL S. was never far back, raced wide through the turn and gradually weakened.
