Footnotes

HAVIN A GOOD DAY bobbled at the start, was allowed to settle in stride, moved outside through the second turn, responded to steady urging and was up in the final yards. TONY'S LEGACY was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, moved up to gain command nearing the three-eighths pole, opened a clear lead and gave way grudgingly to the winner late. MR. ICHIBAN was never far back, raced wide through the second turn, moved up for a contending position in mid-stretch, steadied from between rivals in the final yards and finished willingly. GUSTAVO chased the leaders from the outside throughout and gradually gave way. RIGHT APPROACH was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and finished with some late run. SAHARA SAM raced off the leaders early, moved up for a striking position into the lane and failed to sustain his rally. BAD TOM was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor. DO BOY broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside and weakened after going six furlongs.
