FOR TWO-YEAR-OLD FILLIES. \$350 to enter, \$350 additional to start. 5% of NWRS gross moneys shall be paid to the eligible nominators of the top 5 finishers. 5% of NWRS gross moneys shall be paid to the eligible nominators of the sires of the top 3 finishers. Remaining moneys to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 15% to third, 7.5% to fourth and 2.5% to fifth. Weights 119 lb. Non-winners of a Stake allowed 2 lb. Non-winners of \$5,500 twice allowed 4 lb. Non-winners of one such race allowed 6 lb. Starters to be named through the entry box by closing time of entries. The conditions of this race may be changed with the consent of the Washington Thoroughbred Breeders' Association. Limited to 12 starters. **NOMINATIONS CLOSED.**

Footnotes

A CLASSIC LIFE pressed the pace racing two wide, forged command entering the stretch, and edged clear under steady urging. CHARMING COLLEEN stalked the pace racing three deep, launched her bid leaving the second turn, finished willingly but was unable to reach the winner. HAVE'N A LARK set the pressured pace racing removed from the rail, bumped with QUEENLEDO near the three-sixteenths pole, weakened thereafter and gave way. BELLA CANTU settled racing in hand, came four wide to make a late rally, but failed to seriously threaten. ROANAWAY BRIDE was allowed to settle into stride, got through to make her rally, but found her best stride too late. QUEENLEDO stalked the pace racing along the inside, ranged up leaving the second turn, was caught in tight and bumped with HAVE'N A LARK with three-sixteenths to run, lost action and quickly dropped out. AMERICA'S GIRL failed to respond. AMELIA TRUE HEART chased the pace racing three wide for a half and tired. The Stewards conducted an inquiry into the bumping incident involving QUEENLEDO and HAVE'N A LARK near the three-sixteenths pole, and determined there to be mutual interference and made no change to the order of finish.
