Footnotes

CUTIE'S SHAMUS raced off the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage TENSE BET in mid-stretch, vied with that rival through the final furlong and proved best. TENSE BET dueled for the lead from the outside, opened a clear margin nearing the quarter, responded when headed by the winner and gave way grudgingly to that rival late. MUFAAJY was never far back while racing along the inside, checked nearing the five-sixteenths pole, lacked racing room nearing the quarter and finished with good energy when clear. ROARING TO GO broke sharply to duel for the lead from between foes and gave way in the drive. COURTING SEATTLE showed brief speed from between rivals, checked back nearing the nine-sixteenths pole, angled out into the lane and finished with good late energy. AMANTE MIO was off slow, raced wide through the turn, moved inside nearing the sixteenth marker and found his best stride late. GRANDEST SLAM chased the leaders from between rivals and gradually weakened. EIGHTY EIGHT was away alertly to duel for the early advantage from the inside and weakened after going a half. THRILLER G broke sharply to show brief speed, angled out nearing the seven-sixteenths pole and weakened soon after.
