WHO'S YOUR NEXT EX was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from the outside, moved up to gain command inside the quarter, drifted through the lane, was quickly straightened away and drew off. MUD STOMPER pressed the pace from the outside, could not match strides with the winner in the drive but finished well to save the place. CLOVIS was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders early, lacked racing room nearing the eighth pole, checked from the inside nearing the sixteenth marker and finished with good courage when clear. DR. BOB broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way in the drive. THE BUFFALO PRINCE was never far back while racing from off the rail and gradually gave way. SNIPES MOUNTAINMAN raced off the pacesetters from the outside and finished evenly in the drive. MAJOR FIB was bumped at the start, moved up quickly to duel for the early advantage from the inside and gave way after three furlongs. EDDIE SPAGHETTI lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not menace. PURPLE FUZZ was bumped at the start, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. PRIVATE NICK was void of early speed, saved ground into the lane and did not offer a bid.
