Footnotes

OLLY BLAST raced off the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage the leaders nearing the five-sixteenths pole, vied with QUAKER RUN through the lane and held off the closing CRYPTS SEEKER to prevail. CRYPTS SEEKER was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished with good energy. QUAKER RUN was never far back, moved up to offer a bid nearing the three-eighths marker and gave way through the final furlong. CLURMOR lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished willingly in the drive. RHYTHM TO RUN was void of early foot, raced wide through the second turn and did not menace. WALLY BALLOU lagged early, moved outside through the second turn and found his best stride late. BERNIE WHITE SHOES chased the pace of PIRACY from the inside, steadied when that rival came over nearing the seven-sixteenths pole and did not threaten thereafter. PIRACY went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, stopped after a half, was ease through the lane and vanned off.
