Footnotes

DEAD EYE lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn, responded to steady urging and was up late. PARKERS BLUFF stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to gain command into the lane, opened up a clear lead with a furlong to run and could not resist the winner. TICHIT raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and finished with a steady bid. PAYASO GRANDE showed no early speed, lugged out through the turn and finished with late interest. SIMBA'S ROAR sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way through the final furlong. SHOWING UP FIRST off a step slow, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. B G'S ALLEY CAT chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after racing a half mile. EVERYDAYIMHUSTLIN raced off the pacesetters from the inside and gradually weakened. K P BRILLY showed brief speed and weakened.
