SOUTHERN SOLUTION lugged out through the first turn, set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin nearing the three-eighths pole, turned back the bid of STAR OF THE DIA with a quarter to run, drifted out through the lane and held sway. RISKY ROAD raced off the leaders early, moved far wide through the second turn, angled out further approaching the stretch and finished with a steady bid. FINANCIAL OFFICER was never far back while racing along the inside and finished evenly in the drive. STAR OF THE DIA chased the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the quarter and failed to sustain his rally in the drive. CHEVRON FLYING was off slow, lagged early, raced off the rail throughout and failed to menace. WHISTLE CAT was pushed out through the first turn, pressed the pace of the winner from the outside and weakened after going three-quarters.
