JESSI J was allowed to settle early, launched her bid from four deep on the second bend, took charge near the eighth pole and was drawing off in the final seventy yards. STAREAUX was unhurried early, moved up between horses on the second turn, angled out six wide near the quarter pole and finished with some courage. SAGEHILL CHARM tracked the early leader, took a short lead near the quarter pole but weakened in the final sixteenth of a mile. SUPER SCRIPT set the early pace and tired in the stretch. SCENT OF HEATHER was in a good position but lacked a late punch. TUKWILAMINA was in the middle of the pack early, drifted out five wide on the second turn and never threatened thereafter. PLAYFUL SARA was never far back while saving ground along the inside but had nothing left in the final quarter of a mile and gave way.
