Footnotes

AKINA chased the leaders from the inside, dropped back nearing the three-eighths pole, remained inside into the stretch, gained command with a furlong to run, drifted out slightly and steadily drew clear. MISS MADAVOR was never far back, raced wide through the second turn, reached a contending position in mid-stretch but failed to gain on the winner in the drive. CANADIA was off slow, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, steadied nearing the eighth pole and finished willingly when clear. HISPANIA was away alertly then dropped off the leaders, moved far outside through the second turn, reached a striking position with a furlong to run but lacked the needed late response. ALLISON RIDGE sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace, gave way to the winner in mid-stretch, steadied when that rival came out and continued to give way. NINA WIN showed no early speed, saved ground throughout, checked nearing the eighth pole and did not menace thereafter. The stewards conducted an inquiry concerning the steadying of ALLISON RIDGE at the eighth pole and after reviewing the films concluded AKINA had drifted out to cause the infraction and was disqualified from first and placed fifth.
