SHUDDLE broke sharply to set a pressured pace, turned back the bid of THIRSTY FOR MORE nearing the half and held EAGLE HARBOR at bay in the drive. EAGLE HARBOR was never far back, raced wide through the second turn, responded when set down for the drive and finished with good late energy. THIRSTY FOR MORE was bumped at the break, pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to engage the winner nearing the half, checked nearing the sixteenths pole while drifting inward and gave way thereafter. THE STOLEN WAY was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the inside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. STYLISH MARGIN lagged early, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. MR. BEAUTIFUL was pinched back at the break, raced off the leaders throughout and failed to rally. FASHION MASTER was bumped at the start, raced far wide through the second turn and gradually weakened.
