D DEVIL broke sharply to stalk the pacesetters from off the rail, angled out nearing the quarter, reached the fore with a furlong to run and held off the closing HICKORY ROAD to prevail. HICKORY ROAD showed no early speed, raced off the rail into the lane, angled out in mid-stretch and finished full of run. FLAMING BULLET was pinched back at the start, raced far wide through the turn and finished with good late energy. YES BAY set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way through the final furlong. J. H. COMMANDER pressed the pace from between rivals for five furlongs and gave way. CASTLE ROMEO lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. CASTLE PINES raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and lacked the needed rally. SEA OF FOG was away alertly to press the pace from the outside and weakened after going a half. SWISS HERO lagged throughout and raced far wide through the turn.
