HEZA WITCH DOCTOR dueled for the lead with BROULEE BEACH from off the rail, disposed of that rival after going a half and quickly drew off. RINGO'S GOLD raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and finished with a steady rally. BUCKLE was never far back, raced wide through the turn and lacked the needed closing response. HENNESSY GOD broke awkwardly, raced wide through the turn and finished with some late run. SEVENTEENMILEDRIIVE lacked early foot, angled outside nearing the five-sixteenths pole and failed to menace. BROULEE BEACH broke sharply to duel for the early advantage from the outside and weakened after going a half. REALLY SWISS chased the leaders from the inside, weakened after going three furlongs, was eased through the lane and vanned off.
