Starters to be named through the entry box by the closing time of entries. RAISE THE BLUFF hopped at the start, was bumped going into the first turn, moved up from between rivals approaching the final turn, angled outside into the stretch, responded to steady urging and proved best late. ZILLAH'S KNIGHT was never far back, moved up from the outside nearing the quarter to launch his rally and finished with good courage to hold the place. EXCLUSIVE EAGLE raced just off the pacesetters from the inside, waited patiently into the lane, found racing room and finished willingly. RENO RINGO broke sharply to set a pressured pace, turned back a bid nearing the five-sixteenths marker and gave way grudgingly in the final sixteenth. SHARPER EDGE was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and finished with good energy. RAGIN NONNO was bumped soon after the start, lacked early speed, raced wide into the lane and found his best stride late. MIDWESTERNER pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the three-eighths pole and gave way in the drive. KEAGAN lacked

early speed, raced wide into the lane and passed tiring foes late. SUNGOLD WONDER raced between foes into the stretch and failed to menace. YOODAMAN was off slow, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. COURTING SEATTLE was bumped at the start, raced wide through both turns and weakened in the drive. PREMIER DIABLO saved ground into the lane and weakened. The rider of RAGIN NONNO lodged an objection against EXCLUSIVE EAGLE concerning the start and after reviewing the films the Stewards made no change.
