Footnotes

FIRST LAST CHANCE raced off the leaders early, angled out into the lane and again nearing the eighth pole, responded to steady urging and was up in the final yards. BRUDDA CLYDE was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the inside, moved up to take a slight edge nearing the three-sixteenths marker but could not resist the winner in the drive. YES IT'S SNOWING was never far back, raced wide through the turn, moved up to offer a bid into the lane but failed to gain in the drive. DON'T BE COY ROY chased the leaders from between rivals throughout and lacked the needed closing response. ALL MY FRIENDS was away alertly to set a pressured pace for a half and gave way. WILD HANK broke awkwardly, lagged early, raced far wide through the turn and failed to menace. ONE COOL GUY was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and was not a factor. BRUCUS lacked early foot, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
