LIL SUSI BEEFCAKES set the pressured pace racing two wide, shook clear through the turn, and was ridden out to maintain a safe advantage. OLY BREW made a long drive racing four wide, was no match for the winner, but was just up to earn the place. PRINCESS TEDDY stalked the pace racing three wide from between horses, but lacked the needed late response when called upon. MANZERITA was slow into stride, made a belated gain from between horses, but found her best stride too late. GENTLE LISSA was hustled along on the inside to attend the pace, but went evenly through the drive. MYSTIC EXPRESS dueled for the lead racing along the inside, but came up empty entering the stretch and dropped out. LIBERTYMARIE raced four wide in the second flight and failed to respond. DAT'S MAUREEN saved ground to no avail.
