MY CREED was caught in tight entering the first turn and was forced to check, settled racing along the inside while never far back, angled out to make his bid with a furlong to run, reeled in FLAMETHROWINTEXAN and quickly edged clear. FLAMETHROWINTEXAN set the pressured pace racing well off the rail, battled gamely through a prolonged drive, but was unable to match strides with the winner late. RANDOM MEMO prompted the pace racing along the inside, weakened slightly during the drive but safely held the show. NUMBER JUAN attended the pace racing in hand along the inside, but went evenly through the drive and failed to threaten. SOCCER DAN was unhurried early, ranged into striking distance through the second turn, offered a mild bid entering the stretch, but failed to sustain the drive. NEVER SURRENDER chased the pace racing five wide, but came up empty after six furlongs and dropped out. MILITARY SINGER broke a step slow and never recovered.
